WANDA'S HEIRLOOM TOMATO PLANTS \$4 EACH

White Currant (cherry) — Sweetest tomato that I have ever tasted! Kids love them. Great producer. First & last of the season's tomatoes. Good in a patio container w/ tall trellis. Everyone's favorite cherry!!

Chocolate Cherry — Super productive plant boast the most flavorful tomato tang. Thin, smooth mahogany skin. Heavy clusters of one inch tomatoes. Good in container.

Cherry Falls — Wonderful for hanging basket, small space or counter pot. 1' x 2' beautiful bush plant. Very heavy producer. A cascade of fruit-laden vines. Sweet, round, bright red fruit.

Sweetie Red Cherry — Known for their extremely sweet flavor & eating right off the vine. Early ripening. Heavy clusters, bright red. Perfect for salads, sauté and snacks. Good for container.

Warren's Yellow Cherry — Huge yield of golden-yellow, very sweet cherrys. Grows in clusters on a low compact bush. Great for pots

Italian Ice (Small/Medium White) — The Italian Ice is a small white to cream-yellow tomato variety that is bursting with a sugary sweet flavor! Good for patios or spots where you don't have full sun. This variety produces high yields of up to 1" sized fruits that ripen from green to white to cream-yellow color.

Sunray – Indeterminate – This golden-orange variety is one of the sweetest yellow tomatoes we have tried. It is the close cousin to the sun sugar tomato, but grows to be slightly bigger weighing around 5-8 ounces. Produces prolifically and all season long! Heat and drought tolerant. Perfect for salads, slicing, or adding to sauces.

Tigerella (Medium Red/Orange) — Perfect golf ball size, red-orange w/ golden stripes. Juicy & tangy sweet flavors. smaller plant. Great in a container.

Marglobe (Medium Red) – Heavy, vigorous vines that produce high yields of large (5-6 oz.), uniform, globe-shaped fruit. Plants are determinate and fruits ripen all at once, making Marglobe a good canning tomato. disease-resistant, good for containers

San Marzano (Roma Red) — Famous bright red slim, plum-type fruit. Great for roasting, paste, juice, sauce & sauté. Good for container. Whole tomato freezes great for fresh tasting winter sauces!

Chocolate Stripes – Large beautiful chocolate mahogany bi-colored beef steak tomato w/ dark brown stripes. Sweet earthy flavor

Black Seaman — Medium-sized brown-pink fruits have olive shading, attractive marbled flesh, rich flavor, potato-leaf foliage, determinate variety

Black Trifele — Very prolific potato leaf plant. Meaty 6 oz fruit, mahogany pear shape that resists cracking. Rich & complex flavor. Good for cooler climate, planters & small spaces.

White Tomesol (Large white) — Cream colored fruit are beautiful, smooth and weigh about 8 ounces each. Sweet, rich taste. Looks great with other tomato colors. Rock star producer!

Amana Orange (orange beefsteak) – Huge orange beefsteak that can grow to 2 lbs. or more, with an average diameter of 5 inches. Flavor is mild and quite pleasant. Heirloom variety named for Amana, lowa area. Indeterminate.

Kellogg's Breakfast (Golden beefsteak) – Voted Sunset magazine's #1 tomato! It is absolutely unique, both for its giant size and golden skin & juice. Makes a great orange Marinara sauce. I call them my show off tomato!

Big Rainbow – Neon red & golden stripe. huge fruit, up to 2 pound! Excellent producer. Beautiful sliced. The perfect BLT tomato!

Mr. Stripey – This old heirloom tomato originally came from the hills of West Virginia and is absolutely wonderful. Huge, beefsteak type tomatoes average 1 to 2 pounds, and are yellow-orange in color with red and pink streaks. Mild, low acid taste. Indeterminate vines.

Romanesco – Highly productive rare Roman tomato. Yields large crops of 12 oz. brilliant-red w/ meaty interiors bursting w/ wonderful, rich & complex flavors. A great sauce tomato and great visual appeal.

Green Zebra — Beautiful bright green w/ yellow stripes. Delicious old-fashioned tomato flavor. 2" size. Heavy producer. Great plate presentation! excellent for containers.

Moonglow — Indeterminate / 85 days / full sun. Medium-sized, bright orange fruits glow with neon intensity against 36" vines. A high yielder, producing loads of tasty, 3 to 4 oz globe shaped fruits that are dense and meaty, with thick walls and few seeds. Flavor is sweet, with a hint of tartness, but without that strong acidic taste.
